Description

Starting on May Day (May 1, 2023), The Manatiki Foundation will be celebrating it's first-ever student art show and calendar contest. Students from Martin and St. Lucie counties are invited to participate in the "Protect, Preserve and Restore our Manatees ecosystem" student art contest. This will be a juried art contest for children, in elementary, middle, and high school. There will be prizes awarded to the winners!

The contest will be judged in 3 different age groups and each group will have 4 student winners with the 1st place winning art department receiving \$200!

- 1st place: \$50 and artwork will be published in the 2024 Manatiki Foundation Calendar
- 2nd place: \$30 and artwork will be published in the 2024 Manatiki Foundation Calendar
 - 3rd place: \$20 and artwork will be published in the 2024 Manatiki Foundation Calendar
 - honorable mention: artwork will be published in the 2024 Manatiki Foundation Calendar

Since this is a contest for youth under the age of 18, those interested in participating must have a parent or legal guardian submit the signed release form confirming that all work is original and prepared solely by the child. Again, the artwork will showcase what the young artists love about manatees and how we can "Protect. Preserve and Restore".
